Safety and Handling Information

Handle LinkSquare with care. It has sensitive optical and electronic components inside. LinkSquare or its battery can be damaged if dropped, burned, punctured, or crushed, or if it comes in contact with liquid. If you suspect damage to LinkSquare or the battery, discontinue use of LinkSquare, as it may cause overheating or injury.

Don't open LinkSquare and don't attempt to repair LinkSquare yourself. Disassembling LinkSquare may damage it or cause injury to you. If LinkSquare is damaged or malfunctions, contact LinkSquare Customer Service at **linksquare**.jo/contact.

Your LinkSquare and battery are integrated. You cannot remove the battery from the LinkSquare. Don't attempt to replace the LinkSquare battery yourself—you may damage the battery, which could cause overheating, fire, and injury. The battery in your LinkSquare should be serviced through Stratio, Inc. and must be recycled or disposed of separately from household waste. Dispose of batteries according to your local environmental laws and guidelines.

Only use chargers marked: Output 5V 1A. If you do not know the voltage and current of your charger, use the included USB cable to charge LinkSquare from your computer. Using damaged cables or chargers, or charging when moisture is present, can cause fire, electric shock, injury, or damage to LinkSquare or other property.

Charging or using LinkSquare in any area with a potentially explosive atmosphere, such as areas where the air contains high levels of flammable chemicals, vapors, or particles (such as grain, dust, or metal powders), may be hazardous. Obey all signs and instructions.

Clean LinkSquare immediately if it comes in contact with anything that may cause stains, or other damage—for example, dirt or sand, ink, makeup, soap, detergent, acids or acidic foods, or lotions. To clean:

- Disconnect all cables and turn LinkSquare off.
- Use a soft, lint-free, dry cloth.
- · Avoid getting moisture in openings.
- · Don't use cleaning products or compressed air.

If liquid splashes on LinkSquare or dust gets on it, wipe it off with a soft, lint-free, dry cloth. Minimize exposing LinkSquare to soap, detergent, acids or acidic foods, and any liquids—for example, salt water, soapy water, pool water, perfume, insect repellent, lotion, sunscreen, oil, adhesive remover, hair dye, and solvents. If your LinkSquare comes into contact with any of these substances,

follow the instructions on page 3.

Observe the following precautions to avoid a LinkSquare explosion or fire.

- Do not drop, disassemble, open, crush, bend, deform, puncture, shred, microwave, incinerate, or paint LinkSquare.
- Do not insert foreign objects into any opening on the LinkSquare, such as the USB port.
- Do not use the LinkSquare if it has been damaged—for example, if cracked, punctured, or harmed by water. Disassembling or puncturing the battery can cause an explosion or fire.
- Do not dry the LinkSquare with an external heat source such as a microwave oven or hair dryer.
- Do not place naked flame sources, such as lighted candles, on or near the product.



When charging LinkSquare, do not handle the plug or charger with wet hands. Failure to observe this precaution could result in electric shock.



The device for operation in the band 2412–2462 MHz is only for indoor use.



LinkSquare is designed to work in ambient temperatures between 32° and 104° F (0° and 40° C). LinkSquare can be damaged and battery life shortened if stored or operated outside of these temperature ranges.



Avoid dramatic changes in temperature or humidity when using the LinkSquare, as condensation may form on or within the product and a significant error can occur in optical analysis.

Stratio, Inc. warrants the included LinkSquare product against defects in materials and workmanship for one (1) year from the date of original retail purchase.
